REGISTRATION FEE:

A non-refundable Registration Fee of **R500** must accompany the Application Form.

SECURING FEE – NON REFUNDABLE:

During the year before a new pupil is due to take up a guaranteed booking, a **Non-refundable** Securing Fee of **R22,000** will be required.

EXTRAS:

- * Private individual Music tuition is offered (a minimum of 10 lessons per term). Please contact the Music Department for the applicable costs. A full term's notice must be given in writing.
- * Stationery and textbooks should be purchased directly from the College's recommended suppliers and are not included in the tuition fees.
- * Sundry charges in respect of aftercare, tours, workshops, courses, printing etc, are payable on presentation of statement. Under no circumstances will pupils be allowed on tours, workshops etc unless tuition fees and sundry charges have been settled.

INSURANCE:

The personal possessions of the pupils attending the College **are not covered** in respect of any risks by the College's insurance. Parents should, if they so desire, make their own arrangements for covering the possessions of their daughters. Despite vigilant and strict precautions, losses do occur from time to time owing to negligence on the part of the girls or to unproven theft. Parents are urged to discourage their daughters from bringing jewellery, cell phones and other expensive and unnecessary items to College.
